### **Friday 12 July**

Seashore Search – Observe what organisms live in the sand and water of our local salt marsh and beach. Have a great time searching for sea creatures with pails, nets and sieves in Assonet Bay. Learn to identify some of our local crab species. Be prepared to get wet and have fun!

### **Friday 19 July**

Hip, Herp, Hooray – Are snakes really slippery? Are turtles really slow? Is it true frogs breathe through their skin? Learn the difference between reptiles and amphibians, and what makes each one special. Meet some of Lloyd Center's herp residents and make your own craft to take home!

### **Friday 26 July**

Totally Turtles -What is a Diamondback Terrapin? Where do these reptiles live and how are they different from other turtles? Are they really slow? Learn more about the only brackish water turtle in the area and how close they may be right now? Our turtles are unique!!

### **Friday 2 August**

Something's Fishy – Fish are fabulous! Come discover the underwater world of these amazing creatures. Then grab a net as we discover the types of fish that live around the Assonet Bay Shores! Be prepared to get wet and have fun!
